

Supply list for Acrylic Class

Paints: (these are only suggested—You basically need red, yellow, blue and white) (the craft acrylic paints will work if you don't want to buy the more expensive acrylic paint. Look for a red, red, a blue, blue and a yellow, yellow.)

Quinacridone Magenta

Ultramarine Blue

Turquoise (Phthalo)

Hansa Yellow Medium

Transparent Yellow Iron Oxide

Transparent Pyrrole Orange

Titanium White

Van Dyke Brown (check the hazard label on this and choose another brown if you want)

Cobalt Teal (optional)

Any other colors that interest you.

Brushes:

1.5 inch wash brush (you can use a foam brush instead) This size brush is good to have for big canvases.

.5 inch flat brush

A small brush to sign your name

A middle sized round brush if desired

Rubber gloves if you want to paint with your fingers.

- Flow release or retarder (optional, you can just use water to thin the paint)
- Gel medium (optional) (this can be used as a glue for collage or for color glazing)
- Palette (you can use paper plates, or palette paper)
- Paper or canvas (watercolor paper works for this as well)
- Water containers
- A small spray bottle (optional)
- A piece of foamcore to use as a support for your paper
- A rag for wiping your brush
- A sponge for texture (natural sponges make more interesting texture)
- Pencil
- Eraser
